Quick install instructions

- 1. Save the 112dB Mikron Reverb License.xml attachment you received with your purchase (or demo license) confirmation email to your computer.
- 2. Download the latest installer from our Product Updates page at www.112db.com/download/mikron/reverb and install the plugin.
- 3. When the installation finishes the 112dB License manager will be started automatically. Drag and drop the 112dB Mikron Reverb License.xml (the one you saved to your computer in Step 1) on the license manager window. Or alternatively, click on 'locate license...', navigate to the folder where you saved the license file, select it, and click 'Open'.
- 4. Close the 112dB License Manager. Launch your favorite AAX/AU/VST host and insert Mikron Reverb as an insert, send, or master effect..

Detailed install instructions

A. Downloading the latest installer


To make sure you are running the latest version of Mikron Reverb please visit our Product Updates page at www.112db.com/download/mikron/reverb and download the latest installer for your operating system. (If you already have a demo with the same version number installed you may skip this step and continue to C. Authorizing the plugin below.)

B. PIUGIN INSTALLATION

Mikron Reverb comes in the form of a single installer for all available plugin formats: VST3, AAX, and Audio Units.

MAC OSX

- 1. Double click the Mikron Reverb Installer. pkg file to start the installer. If everything goes as expected, you will now see the welcome screen shown on the right.
- 2. You might want to have a quick look at the readme, as it may contain important last-minute information that was not available at the time of writing.
- 3. You will be asked to agree to the terms of the license agreement.
- 4. The installer installs all plugin formats (VST3, AAX, and Audio Units) by default.



- 5.. You will be prompted for your Mac password to complete the installation.
- 6. If the installer detects you haven't activated your license yet, the 112dB License Manager will be started.

WINDOWS


1. Double click the Mikron Reverb Installer.exe file to run the setup program.

Windows might give you the following warning: 'Microsoft Defender SmartScreen prevented an unrecognized app from starting. Running this app might put your PC at risk'

No need to worry, this simply means that the installer is too new to be recognized by Microsoft Defender yet. We can assure you that we're not in the habit of putting malware in our plugins, so if you downloaded the installer from our website, you can safely ignore this. Click on 'More info'. Make sure that 112dB is mentioned as Publisher. Then click 'Run Anyway'.

Depending on your system settings, you now might get

another message: 'Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?' Click 'yes' to continue with the installation.




2. If everything goes as expected, you will now see the welcome screen shown on the left.

Windows protected your PC

- 3. In the next step you will be asked to agree to the terms of the license agreement.
- 4. The installer installs all plugin formats (VST3 and AAX) by default.
- 5. When Mikron Reverb has been installed, Setup is complete and you may click the Finish button. By default 'Start the 112dB License Manager' will be selected. Keep it selected if you haven't activated your license yet, and want to activate it now. If you already have a license installed, you can deselect it.
- 6. You might want to have a quick look at the readme, that was installed in \Program Files\112dB\Mikron Reverb, as it may contain important last-minute information that was not available at the time of writing.



C. AUTHORIZING THE PLUGIN

With your purchase or demo download you should have received an email containing a license file (in the form of an XML-document). Save this file to your computer.

The 112dB License Manager will be started automatically after the installation is finished. Drag and drop your license file on the License Manager window. Or alternatively click on 'locate license...', navigate to the folder where you saved the license file, select it, and click 'Open'. You can decide to skip this step, and activate your license later from within the plugin.

FROM DEMO TO PERMANENT LICENSE

To replace a demo license with a permanent license, first save the permanent XML license from your

purchase confirmation email to your computer. Open the 112dB License Manager (see 'Where can I find the License Manager?' below). Drag and drop your license file on the license manager window to activate Mikron Reverb. Or alternatively, click on 'locate license...', navigate to the folder where you saved the license file, select it, and click 'Open'. In your License Overview you will now see 'perpetual' instead of a specific expiry date for Mikron Reverb under 'Expiration Date'.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Some email clients do not like plain text attachments. For this reason the license is attached in both text (.xml) and zipped (.zip) formats. If you receive an error message saying that the 112dB Mikron Reverb .xml license is invalid or corrupt, the most likely cause is that it got corrupted during email transfer. In this case please save the 112dB Mikron Reverb License.zip attachment to your computer instead, unzip the file (this will produce a 112dB Mikron Reverb License .xml file) and try authorizing again.

INSTALLING ON MULTIPLE COMPUTERS

The license file you received is not tied to a specific computer, only to a specific person. You can use the same license file to authorize the plugin on any system, as long as it is yours. This way you can install and use the plugin on your studio setup, your home computer, and your travel notebook at the same time.
